ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

SECRETARY OF STATE STATE OF MASHINGTON

NORTH SEATTLE COMMUNITY COLLEGE FOUNDATION

The undersigned, in order to form a nonprofit corporation under Chapter 4.03 of the Revised Code of Washington, hereby signs and verifies the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is North Seattle Community College Foundation (hereinafter referred to as the "Foundation").

ARTICLE II

The duration of the Foundation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III

The initial registered office of the Foundation is The President's Office, North Seattle Community College, 9600 College Way North, Seattle, Washington 98103, and the initial registered agent at such address is Barbara R. Daum.

ARTICLE IV

Section 1. <u>Purposes</u>. To operate exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary, or educational purposes, within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, including promoting, supporting, maintaining, developing, and extending educational offerings and the pursuit thereof at or in connection with the North Seattle Community College.

Section 2. Limitations.

- 2.1 The Foundation shall have no capital stock, and no part of its net earnings shall inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member of the Foundation, or any private individuals.
- 2.2 No director, officer or member of the Foundation, nor any private individual shall be entitled to share in the distribution of any of the Foundation assets upon dissolution of the Foundation, or the winding up of its affairs. Upon such dissolution or winding up, all the remaining assets of the Foundation shall be distributed to North Seattle Community College.
- 2.3 No substantial part of the activities of the Foundation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting, to influence legislation except as may be permitted to Section 501(c)(3) organizations by the Internal Revenue Code, and the Foundation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publication or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
- 2.4 Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, the Foundation shall not conduct or carry on activities not permitted to be conducted or carried on by an organization exempt under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code as now stated, or as it may be hereafter amended,

or by organization contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of such Code as now stated, or as it may be hereafter amended.

Section 3. <u>Powers</u>. In general, and subject to such limitations and conditions as are or may be prescribed by law, or in the Foundation's Articles of Incorporation or Bylaws, the Foundation shall have all powers which now or are hereafter conferred by law upon a Foundation organized for the purpose hereinabove set forth, or necessary or incidental to the powers so conferred, or conducive to the attainment of the purpose of the corporation.

ARTICLE V

- 1. The management of the Foundation will be vested in a board of no less than three (3) directors. The number, qualifications, terms of office, manner of election, time and place of meeting, and powers and duties of directors shall be such as are prescribed by the Bylaws of the Foundation.
- 2. The names and addresses of the directors who will first manage the affairs of the Foundation until the first annual meeting of the board, as provided in the Bylaws, and until their successors are elected and qualified, are:
