As a result, a refund for \$200.00 will be forwarded to you from the State Treasurer's office. Please allow 4-6 weeks for processing.

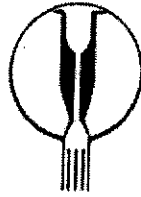
