PLAN OF COMPLETE LIQUIDATION AND DISSOLUTION

This Plan of Complete Liquidation and Dissolution ("Plan") is for the purpose of effecting the complete liquidation, as necessary, and dissolution of Allio Associates, LLC, a Rhode Island limited liability company (the "Company") in accordance with applicable state and federal tax laws, and the Rhode Island Limited Liability Company Act (the "Act").
