PLAN OF LIQUIDATION OF

S. Parfitt Construction, Inc.

This Plan of Liquidation is for the purpose of effecting the complete liquidation and dissolution of S. Parfitt Construction Inc, a Rhode Island corporation (the "Corporation"), in accordance with Section 337 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, in the following manner:

- 1. This Plan shall be submitted for approval to the shareholders of the Corporation, and shall be effective upon its adoption by the shareholders of the Corporation.
- 2. Upon approval of this Plan as aforesaid, the Corporation after payment of or provision for payment of all liabilities of the Corporation, shall distribute to said shareholders, from time to time, in complete cancellation and redemption of their stock, all of the property and assets of the Corporation.
