FIFTH: Definitions.

MISSION STATEMENT, ELIBIBILITY AND BENEFITS

<u>Section 1.</u> MISSION STATEMENT – The 100 Club of Rhode Island shall have a primary purpose of providing financial support to the families of fallen active and volunteer Fire and Rescue personnel and active Law Enforcement personnel.

Section 2. ELIGIBILITY – Death benefits shall only be available to immediate Family members, defined as Spouses, Common Law Spouses, or Children, including Adopted and Stepchildren, of active Fire, Rescue and Law Enforcement personnel Whose death is the result of a job related accident. A ruling of any governmental Or investigatory body determining that the cause of death is job related shall not alone constitute eligibility. The Benefits Committee may only provide benefits after review and acceptance as to the job related nature of death. Limited benefits or special exemptions may be awarded by a 2/3-majority vote of the Board of Directors in such cases that do not meet the above requirements and shall be awarded only if the expected costs are within the limits of anticipated available funds as determined by the Investment Committee.

<u>Section 3.</u> BENEFITS – Benefits may include but are not limited to a one-time Death benefit to the surviving spouse or dependents, U.S. Savings Bonds for dependent children under the age of 18, and scholarships for higher education.

Benefits may be adjusted and modified from time to time by a majority vote of the Board of Directors as deemed necessary for the preservation of the solvency of the Corporation and are subject to the limits of revenue anticipation as determined by the Investment Committee. Initial awards of benefits shall not constitute a contract, promise or guarantee of future payment of benefits and shall be subject to the availability of funds. BI ANI
