Purpose Clause: Life Changes - Resource Center is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes including for distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any federal tax code.

Dissolution Clause: Upon the dissolution of the organization, Life Changes - Cancer Resource Center, the assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principle office of Life Changes - Cancer Resource Center is then located, exclusively for such organizations or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
