Holiday Heros, Inc. Addendum to Question # 4.

This corporation is organized and operated exclusively for the charitable/educational/religious/scientific or other purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) Internal Revenue Code. The specific purpose of the corporation is to host fundraising events from which money raised will be donated to pre-designated public non-profit organizations and charities. Examples of such recipients are Hasbro Children's Hospital, American Red Cross disaster relief funds, and various non-profit charitable organizations. Selection of recipients will be made by our Board of Directors on a quarterly basis.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these activities, Holiday Heros, Inc., shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law) or by an organization contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue United States Internal Revenue Law).

Upon the dissolution of this Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future tax code), or shall be distributed to the Federal Government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed or shall be disposed of by the Superior Court (or Court of Common Pleas) of the County in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively

for such purposes or to such organizations as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
