You can mail the form to us with your payment or visit our office to file in person. Of course, we will provide a hardcopy of the Change of Resident Agent/Address form upon request.

The filing must be made with the Office of the Secretary of State, Corporations Division, within the next sixty (60) days to ensure your authority to conduct business will remain intact.
