Exhibit A to Article 4
of the Articles of Incorporation of
Nathan Bishop Middle School Parent Teacher Organization

- A. The corporation is not organized for profit, and no part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article 3 hereof.

- B. Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the board of directors (as that term is defined by the Rhode Island Nonprofit Corporation Act) of the corporation shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable and educational purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law), as the board of directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Superior Court of the county in which the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
