Certificate of Incorporation.

We, the subscribers, certify that we do hereby associate ourselves as a body politic and corporate under the statute laws of the State of Connecticut; and we further certify:

FIRST: That the name of the corporation is The F. J. Dahill Company.

SECOND: That said corporation is to be located in the town of New Haven, County of New Haven and State of Connecticut.

THIRD: That the nature of the business to be transacted, and the purposes to be promoted or carried out, by said corporation, are as follows: A general contracting business, including therein the repairing, hooping or raising of factory chimneys, pointing of all kinds of stone and brick work, repairing, painting and gilding church steeples, spires, flagstaffs and any other business in any way connected with steeples or chimneys or the purchase or sale of supplies of all kinds in

connection therewith or anything incident thereto.
