ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED:

1. That the Final Report of Theodore Orson, Temporary and Permanent Receiver herein, and all acts, doings, and disbursements of said Receiver are hereby approved, confirmed and ratified.
2. That the Recommendation on Allowance of Claims filed herein by said Receiver is hereby approved.
3. That the Receiver is hereby authorized and directed to engage attorney Janet Goldman of Goldman Law Ltd. to prosecute a claim against Mr. Christopher White on a 33% contingency fee basis. Ms. Goldman is authorized to pay any recovery directly to Citizens Bank, net of said contingency fee and all reasonable out-of-pocket expenses. Ms. Goldman is further authorized to seek approval of any settlement directly from Citizens Bank.
4. That the administrative claim of Normand Law, Ltd. in the amount of \$792.00 is hereby allowed the Receiver is directed to pay such allowed administrative claim in cash in full.

5. That the administrative claim of Muto, Vollucci & Co., Ltd., in the amount of \$30,141.00 is hereby allowed the Receiver is directed to pay such allowed administrative claim in cash in full.

6. That the administrative claim of Receiver in the amount of \$ 109,780.93 is hereby allowed the Receiver is directed to pay such allowed administrative claim in cash in full.

7. That the Receiver is authorized and directed to pay the remaining balance of funds in the estate to Citizens Bank on account of its allowed claim except that the Receiver may hold back \$5,000 to settle an administrative claim with United Health. Any funds remaining after such settlement shall be paid to Citizens Bank.

8. That said Receiver is hereby authorized to abandon all Respondent's books and records and any outstanding assets.


9. That said Receiver is hereby discharged and the Receivership Bond ordered cancelled.


