**Non-Profit Corporation
Restated Articles of Incorporation**

(Section 7-6-42 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, as amended)

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is PL-AIDS Project (Partners in Learning about AIDS Project)

ARTICLE II

The period of its duration is perpetual

ARTICLE III

The specific purpose or purposes which the corporation is authorized to pursue are:

PL-AIDS Project is an HIV/AIDS advocacy and prevention organization that seeks to reduce the spread of HIV/AIDS and focuses heavily on the development and promotion of biomedical HIV prevention strategies. Founded by Brown University medical and public health students, at its core, this corporation has a specific mission to bring Brown University undergraduate, graduate, and medical students to global sites where unique cultural exchanges can develop between local collaborators and Brown students with the eventual goal of assisting in the creation of culturally relevant public health interventions tailored to local cultures. No less important is the organization's interest in engaging directly with local communities. PL-AIDS Project seeks to help develop novel biomedical HIV prevention strategies for high-risk BGLT, Latino, and Asian communities within the southern New England area.

ARTICLE IV

Any other provisions, not inconsistent with law, which are presently set forth in the Articles of Incorporation as theretofore amended are as follows: *(If there are no other such provisions, so state.)*

UPON THE DISSOLUTION OF THE ORGANIZATION, ASSETS SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED FOR ONE OR MORE EXEMPT PURPOSES WITHIN THE MEANING OF SECTION 501(C)(3) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE, OR CORRESPONDING SECTION OF ANY FUTURE FEDERAL TAX CODE, OR SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED TO THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, OR TO A STATE OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT, FOR A PUBLIC PURPOSE. ANY SUCH ASSETS NOT DISPOSED OF SHALL BE DISPOSED OF BY THE COURT OF COMMON PLEAS OF THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE PRINCIPAL OFFICE OF THE ORGANIZATION OR ORGANIZATIONS, AS SAID COURT SHALL DETERMINE, WHICH ARE ORGANIZATION AND OPERATED EXCLUSIVELY FOR SUCH PURPOSES.

ARTICLE V

These Restated Articles of Incorporation correctly set forth, without change, the corresponding provisions of the Articles of Incorporation as theretofore amended, have been duly adopted as required by law, and supersede the original Articles of Incorporation and all amendments thereto.
