Purposes Restated as of July 1, 1998

The Corporation is organized and shall be operated for charitable, educational and scientific purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 and in furtherance but without limitation thereof shall:

1. Identify community needs, and develop plans, as to human services programs.
2. Deliver human services through a comprehensive program of community living, counseling and other outpatient care, education, mediation, advocacy and other services or treatment programs including programs for the mentally ill, emotionally disturbed, mentally retarded, developmentally disabled, substance abusers, families, the elderly and other populations. All residential programs shall be provided for educational purposes.
3. Provide a continuum of care and education for children and youth who are experiencing, or are at a high risk to experience, significant personal, familial or societal problems.
4. Operate an outpatient mental health clinic.
5. Encourage, support and cooperate with public agencies and private organizations in the planning, development and operation of human services programs.
6. Sponsor and conduct forums, lectures, workshops and other public education programs concerning needs for, and the provision of, human services.
