**Non-Profit Corporation
Restated Articles of Incorporation**

(Section 7-6-42 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, as amended)

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is Lonsdale Parents & Teachers

ARTICLE II

The period of its duration is perpetual

ARTICLE III

The specific purpose or purposes which the corporation is authorized to pursue are:

PARENT AND TEACHER ORGANIZATION

ARTICLE IV

Any other provisions, not inconsistent with law, which are presently set forth in the Articles of Incorporation as theretofore amended are as follows: *(If there are no other such provisions, so state.)*

DESCRIPTION/PURPOSE

A)THE ORGANIZATION IS ORGANIZED EXCLUSIVELY FOR THE CHARITABLE, SCIENTIFIC, LITERARY OR EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES WITHIN THE MEANING OF SECTION 501(C)(3) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OR CORRESPONDING SECTION OF ANY FUTURE FEDERAL TAX CODE (HEREINAFTER "INTERNAL REVENUE CODE").

B)THE ORGANIZATION SHALL BE NONCOMMERCIAL, NONSECTARIAN, AND NONPARTISAN.

C) THE NAME OF THE ORGANIZATION OR THE NAMES OF ANY MEMBERS IN THEIR OFFICIAL CAPACITIES SHALL NOT BE USED TO ENDORSE OR PROMOTE A COMMERCIAL CONCERN OR IN CONNECTION WITH ANY PARTISAN INTEREST OR FOR ANY PURPOSE NOT APPROPRIATELY RELATED TO PROMOTION OF THE OBJECTS OF THE ORGANIZATION.

D) THE ORGANIZATION SHALL NOT, DIRECTLY OR INDIRECTLY, PARTICIPATE OR INTERVENE (IN ANY WAY, INCLUDING THE PUBLISHING OR DISTRIBUTING OF STATEMENTS) IN ANY POLITICAL CAMPAIGN ON BEHALF OF, OR IN OPPOSITION TO, ANY CANDIDATE FOR PUBLIC OFFICE OR DEVOTE MORE THAN AN INSUBSTANTIAL PART OF ITS ACTIVITIES IN ATTEMPTING TO INFLUENCE LEGISLATION BY

PROPAGANDA OR OTHERWISE.

E) THE ORGANIZATION SHALL WORK WITH THE SCHOOLS TO PROVIDE QUALITY EDUCATION FOR ALL CHILDREN AND YOUTH AND SHALL SEEK TO PARTICIPATE IN THE DECISION-MAKING PROCESS ESTABLISHING SCHOOL POLICY, RECOGNIZING THAT THE LEGAL RESPONSIBILITY TO MAKE DECISIONS HAS BEEN DELEGATED BY THE PEOPLE TO BOARDS OF EDUCATION, STATE EDUCATION AUTHORITIES, AND LOCAL EDUCATION AUTHORITIES.

F) NO PART OF THE NET EARNINGS OF THE ORGANIZATION SHALL INURE TO THE BENEFIT OF, OR BE DISTRIBUTABLE TO ITS MEMBERS, DIRECTORS, TRUSTEES, OFFICERS, OR OTHER PRIVATE INDIVIDUALS EXCEPT THAT THE ORGANIZATION SHALL BE AUTHORIZED AND EMPOWERED TO PAY REASONABLE COMPENSATION FOR SERVICES RENDERED AND TO MAKE PAYMENTS AND DISTRIBUTIONS IN FURTHERANCE OF THE PURPOSES SET FORTH IN ARTICLE II HEREOF.

G) NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THESE ARTICLES, THE ORGANIZATION SHALL NOT CARRY ON ANY OTHER ACTIVITIES NOT PERMITTED TO BE CARRIED ON (I) BY AN ORGANIZATION EXEMPT FROM FEDERAL INCOME TAX UNDER SECTION 501(C)(3) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OR (II) BY AN ORGANIZATION, CONTRIBUTIONS TO WHICH ARE DEDUCTIBLE UNDER SECTION 170(C)(2) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE.

DISSOLUTION

A) UPON DISSOLUTION OF THIS ORGANIZATION, AFTER PAYING OR ADEQUATELY PROVIDING FOR THE DEBTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF THIS LPT, THE REMAINING ASSETS SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED TO LONSDALE ELEMENTARY SCHOOL. IF THE SCHOOL SHALL CEASE TO EXIST, REMAINING LPT ASSETS SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED FOR ONE OR MORE EXEMPT PURPOSES WITHIN THE MEANING OF SECTION 501 (C) (3) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE, OR CORRESPONDING SECTION OF ANY FUTURE FEDERAL TAX CODE, OR SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED TO THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, OR TO A STATE OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT, FOR A PUBLIC PURPOSE.

ARTICLE V

These Restated Articles of Incorporation correctly set forth, without change, the corresponding provisions of the Articles of Incorporation as theretofore amended, have been duly adopted as required by law, and supersede the original Articles of Incorporation and all amendments thereto.
