AN ACT IN AMENDMENT OF AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE  
"CONGREGATIONAL SOCIETY OF WOONSOCKET VILLAGE, IN  
SMITHFIELD."

*It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows :*

SECTION 1. The religious society now known by the name of the Congregational Society of Woonsocket village, in Smithfield, shall hereafter be known by the name of the "Globe Congregational Society of Smithfield."

SEC. 2. An act entitled "an act in amendment of an act to incorporate the First Congregational Society of Woonsocket," passed at the present session of the general assembly, is hereby repealed.

*It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows :*

SECTION 1. James Davis, Thomas K. King, Ansel D. Nickerson, William E. Tolman, Everett P. Carpenter, William F. Sayles, John A. Adams, George D. Allen, Oliver L. Hackett, Thomas P. Barnefield, Lewis Fairbrother, Sumner Fifield, Horace Daniels, William H. Colwell, H. S. Fifield and P. E. Tillinghast, their associates, and such others as hereafter may be admitted members of this corporation, are hereby constituted and created a body corporate and politic, for the purpose of establishing and maintaining a reading room, library, and other means, for the improvement of the spiritual, moral and mental condition of young men, by the name of the "Pawtucket and Central Falls Young Men's Christian Association," and by that name shall have perpetual succession, and are made able and capable in law to have, possess, hold, enjoy, purchase, receive and retain unto them, their successors and assigns, estates of every kind and nature, real, personal or mixed, to an amount not exceeding forty thousand dollars, and with all the rights and privileges and subject to all the duties and liabilities set forth in chapter 125 of the revised statutes, and all acts in amendment thereof or in addition thereto.
