Articles of Incorporation**

(Chapter 7-1.2- of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, as amended)

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is 3 Guys Hydroponics, Inc.

This is a close corporation pursuant to § 7-1.2-1701 of the General Laws, 1956, as amended. (Uncheck if inapplicable.)

ARTICLE II

The total number of shares which the corporation has authority to issue is:

PROVISIONS (IF ANY) DEALING WITH THE PREEMPTIVE RIGHT OF SHAREHOLDERS PURSUANT TO §7-1.2-613 OF THE GENERAL LAWS, 1956, AS AMENDED:

ANY STOCKHOLDER, INCLUDING THE HEIRS, ASSIGNS, EXECUTORS, OR ADMINISTRATORS OF A DECEASED STOCKHOLDER, DESIRING TO SELL, TRANSFER OR PLEDGE SUCH STOCK OWNED BY HIM OR THEM, SHALL FIRST OFFER IT TO THE CORPORATION THROUGH THE OFFICERS, IN THE MANNER FOLLOWING:

HE SHALL NOTIFY THE OFFICERS OF HIS DESIRE TO SELL OR TRANSFER BY NOTICE IN WRITING, WHICH NOTICE SHALL CONTAIN THE PRICE AT HE IS WILLING TO SELL OR TRANSFER AND THE NAME OF ONE ARBITRATOR. THE OFFICERS SHALL WITHIN THIRTY DAYS THEREAFTER EITHER ACCEPT THE OFFER, OR BY NOTICE TO HIM IN WRITING NAME A SECOND ARBITRATOR, AND THESE TWO SHALL NAME A THIRD. IT SHALL THEN BE THE DUTY OF THE ARBITRATORS TO ASCERTAIN THE VALUE OF THE STOCK, AND IF ANY ARBITRATOR SHALL NEGLECT OR REFUSE TO APPEAR AT ANY MEETING APPOINTED BY THE ARBITRATORS, A MAJORITY MAY ACT IN THE ABSENCE OF SUCH ARBITRATOR.

AFTER THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE OFFER, OR THE REPORT OF THE ARBITRATORS AS TO THE VALUE OF THE STOCK, THE OFFICERS SHALL HAVE THIRTY (30) DAYS WITHIN WHICH TO PURCHASE THE SAME AT SUCH VALUATION, BUT IF AT THE EXPIRATION OF THIRTY DAYS, THE CORPORATION SHALL NOT HAVE EXERCISED THE RIGHT SO TO PURCHASE, THE OWNER OF THE STOCK SHALL BE AT LIBERTY TO DISPOSE OF THE SAME IN ANY MANNER HE MAY SEE FIT.

NO SHARES OF STOCK SHALL BE SOLD OR TRANSFERRED ON THE BOOKS OF THE CORPORATION UNTIL THESE PROVISIONS HAVE BEEN COMPLIED WITHIN, BUT THE OFFICERS MAY IN ANY

PARTICULAR INSTANCE WAIVE THE REQUIREMENTS.
