**Non-Profit Corporation
Restated Articles of Incorporation**

(Section 7-6-42 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, as amended)

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is Exeter West Greenwich Youth Football and Cheerleading

If the entity's name is changing, state the new name: Exeter West Greenwich Youth Football and Cheerleading

ARTICLE II

If the corporate duration is changing, so state: Perpetual

If the corporate purpose is changing, so state:

Exeter West Greenwich (EWG) Youth Football and Cheerleading is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The general objective of the League is to inspire the youth of Exeter and West Greenwich to participate in youth football and cheerleading activities, regardless of race, creed, color, sex and/or national origin, and to encourage all participants to practice the ideals of good sportsmanship, physical fitness and scholastic achievement.

Upon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government or to a state or local government for a public purpose.

In the event that the League is dissolved for any reason, ownership of all tangible League assets held at the time of dissolution, including but not limited to cash, equipment, uniforms, etc., shall be conveyed directly to the Exeter/West Greenwich, RI school system or its heirs or assigns, and no other persons, organizations or entities superior to, subsidiary to or affiliated with the League shall have any rights thereto, with the exception of those persons, organizations or entities having valid legal claims (e.g. liens) against the League at the time of dissolution. In such cases, all tangible League assets shall be held by the League (or a duly authorized designee) until such time as the legal claims have been resolved, at which point said assets shall be used to resolve any and all outstanding judgments, expenses or fees due the persons, organizations or entities. The tangible League assets remaining after said judgments, expenses or fees have been resolved shall then be conveyed to the Exeter/West Greenwich school system.

Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction in Kent County or the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
