ORDER APPOINTING TEMPORARY RECEIVER

The above-identified proceeding having come before the Honorable Associate Justice Brian A. Stern on this 28th day of August, 2012, upon Petitioner, Independence Bank's ("IB") Petition for Appointment of a Receiver, and after considering the papers and pleadings in this matter, as well as the statements and representations of the parties, pursuant to an in-chambers conference, it is hereby

ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED

1. That Jeffrey B. Cianciolo, Esq., of Providence, Rhode Island, be, and hereby is, appointed Temporary Receiver (the "Receiver") of Respondent, Jonco, LLC ("Jonco").
2. That said Receiver shall, no later than five (5) days from the date hereof, file a bond in the sum of Five Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$5,000.00) with any surety company authorized to do business in the State of Rhode Island as surety thereon, conditioned that the Receiver will well and truly perform the duties of said office and duly account for all monies and property which may come into the Receiver's hands and abide by and perform all things which the Receiver will be directed to do by this Court.

3. That said Receiver is authorized to take possession and charge of the property and/or assets of Jonco, and to collect any and all rents, debts and/or property belonging to Jonco, and to preserve the same until further order of this Court.

4. That said Receiver is authorized until further order of this Court, in the Receiver's discretion, and as said Receiver deems appropriate and advisable, to preserve the asset and prevent waste of Jonco's assets and/or property, to borrow money from time to time, to purchase for cash or upon credit, merchandise, materials and other property, to engage employees and assistants, clerical or otherwise, and to do and perform or cause to be done and performed all other acts and things as are appropriate in the premises.

5. That, pursuant to and in compliance with Rhode Island Supreme Court Executive Order No. 95-01, this Court finds that the designation of the aforescribed person for appointment as Receiver is warranted and required because of the Receiver's specialized expertise.

6. That the commencement, prosecution, or continuance of the prosecution of any action, suit, arbitration proceeding, hearing, or any foreclosure, reclamation or repossession proceeding, both judicial and non-judicial, or any other proceeding, in law, or in equity or under any statute, or otherwise, against Jonco, or any of Jonco's property and/or assets, in any Court, agency, tribunal, or elsewhere, or before any arbitrator, or otherwise by any creditor, stockholder, corporation, partnership or any other person, or the levy of any attachment, execution or other process upon or against any property of Jonco, or the taking or attempting to take into possession any property in the possession of Jonco or of which Jonco has the right to possession, or the cancellation at any time during the instant receivership proceeding herein of any insurance policy, lease or other contract with Jonco, by any of such parties as aforesaid, other than the Receiver

designated as aforesaid, or the termination of telephone, electric, gas or other utility service to Jonco, by any public utility, without prior approval thereof from this Court, in which connection said Receiver shall be entitled to prior notice and an opportunity to be heard, are hereby restrained and enjoined until further order of this Court.

7. That a Citation be issued to Jonco, returnable to the Superior Court sitting at Newport County, Rhode Island on SEPT 24th, 2012, at 9:30 a.m., at which time and place this cause is set down for hearing on the prayer for the Appointment of a Permanent Receiver; that the Clerk of this Court shall give notice of the pendency of the Petition herein by publishing this Order Appointing Temporary Receiver once in The Providence Journal on or before SEPT 24th, 2012, so long as the Receiver's Bond has been filed, and the Receiver shall give further notice by mailing, on or before SEPT 14th, 2012, a copy of said Order Appointing Temporary Receiver to each of Jonco's creditors and stockholders whose address is known or may become known to the Receiver.







MOTION TO ENGAGE PROFESSIONALS

NOW COMES, the Temporary Receiver, Jeffrey Cianciolo, Esq., in his official capacity and not individually and hereby moves this Honorable Superior Court for permission to Engage Professionals. As grounds for this Motion, your Receiver states:

1. The Court appointed the Temporary Receiver on or about August 28, 2012.
2. Pursuant to the Order of appointment, Your Temporary Receiver has taken steps to obtain the necessary bond, advertise the matter, and give notice to all known creditors to the Estate.
3. Your Temporary Receiver has had extensive discussions with the Petitioner and primary creditor in this case, Independence Bank. 
your Temporary Receiver and the law firm of Ferrucci Russo, P.C. have in the past been successful in operating assets of this kind, specifically hotels.
