The CG was exposed to a control environment (CE) and the EG was exposed to an experimental environment (EE). The EE was designed to simulate a real-world environment with various stimuli (e.g., visual, auditory, and olfactory) and a complex task (e.g., navigation and decision-making). The subjects were exposed to the EE for a period of 24 hours.
