Mathies Santos	Degree Granting Institutions. Chapter 40 of Title 16 of the Rhode Island General Laws indicates that to transact business in this state and to grant academic, collegiate, professional, or similar degrees, an institution must be non-profit, must receive the prior authorization of the Rhode Island Board of Governors for Higher Education ("Board"), and must have received full New England Association of Schools and Colleges (NEASC) accreditation within "five years of its incorporation or establishment within this state or five years of being permitted to transact business within this state." (RIGL§16-40-1 and §16-40-2) As such, a for-profit institution that wishes to grant academic, collegiate, professional, or similar degrees within this state must obtain such authorization through the enactment of specific legislation by the state's General Assembly.	
	Additional procedures, standards, and requirements regarding the authorization of non-profit degree granting institutions are set forth in the Board's <i>Regulations Governing Institutions of Higher Education Operating in Rhode Island</i> , which may be found at <u>http://www.ribghe.org/hiedreg.htm</u> . These regulations also set forth a definition for "operate or operating" a degree granting institution in Rhode Island.
