Section 1. Be it enacted by the General bly, and by the authority thereof it is enacted, Nathaniel Phillips, William Collins, Seth John Pearce, John Trott, George Munro, W. Carr, John Stockford, A. Burr, Nathan Child and John Wheaton, together with such others as may after become members of this incorporation forever a body corporate and politic, by the of St. Mark's Church Society, in the town of ren, for the more essential support of publicati ship in St. Mark's Church, in said Warren, so ing to the rites and usages of the Protestant E copal Church in the United States; and the society are hereby authorized, and full power hereby given unto them, to take, receive and all monies raised by voluntary subscription, con bution and donations; and also to receive and all legacies and estates which have been been fore or may at any time hereafter be given: they are also empowered to bave, possess and quire lands, tenements, hereditaments, of goods and chattels, not exceeding, at any out

bry thousand dollars; and shall be capable in law, as a body corporate, to sue and be sued, to plead and be impleaded, defend and be defended spainst in all courts and places, and before all proper judges whatsoever; and also have a common seal, and the same break, alter or renew at pleasure.

Sec. 2. And be it further enacted, That there stall be a meeting of the society aforesaid on Easter Monday, yearly, forever, for the purpose of regulating their business, electing wardens, vestry, ecretary and treasurer; and the wardens of the ociety be and they are hereby authorized to contine the parishioners of St. Mark's Church society, any time and place in Warren when they judge it advantageous to the interests of the ociety.

Sec. S. And be it further enacted, That the wartens and vestry, who have been elected to their spective offices, be and they are hereby continted in office until the annual meeting on Easter londay next.

Sec. 4. And be it further enacted, That a proper tolk or books shall be provided by the society, or the purpose of registering and keeping an active account of all subscriptions, contributions, excess and donations made to their society; and to the names of the donors, their places of residice, and the time of their being made.

Sec. 5. And be it further enacted.
