

cense, duly issued and in force at the time of the alleged offence; and in every such case the justice or warden who shall try the same, is hereby authorized to enforce the payment of such costs by a writ of execution, if the prosecution is by action of debt, and by a mittimus, if the prosecution is by information or complaint.

Sec. 5. *And be it further enacted*, That so much of every act heretofore passed in relation to hawking and peddling, as is repugnant to the provisions of this act, be and the same is hereby repealed.

AN ACT to incorporate certain persons by the name of St. Mark's Church Society, in Warren.

St. Mark's
Church.

Whereas divers persons have petitioned the assembly for an act of incorporation, whereby they may be enabled to promote the purposes set forth in their petition, as hereinafter mentioned:

Section 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly, and by the authority thereof it is enacted*, That Nathaniel Phillips, William Collins, Seth Pearce, John Pearce, John Trott, George Munro, William Carr, John Stockford, A. Humphreys, Charles Wheaton, E. W. Burr, Nathan Child and John Wheaton, together with such others as may hereafter become members of this incorporation, be and they are forever a body corporate and politic, by the name of St. Mark's Church Society, in the town of Warren, for the more essential support of public worship in St. Mark's Church, in said Warren, according to the rites and usages of the Protestant Episcopal Church in the United States; and the said society are hereby authorized, and full powers are hereby given unto them, to take, receive and hold all monies raised by voluntary subscription, contribution and donations; and also to receive and hold all legacies and estates which have been heretofore or may at any time hereafter be given; and they are also empowered to have, possess and acquire lands, tenements, hereditaments, or goods and chattels, not exceeding, at any one time

forty thousand dollars; and shall be capable in law, as a body corporate, to sue and be sued, to plead and be impleaded, defend and be defended against in all courts and places, and before all proper judges whatsoever; and also have a common seal, and the same break, alter or renew at pleasure.

Sec. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That there shall be a meeting of the society aforesaid on Easter Monday, yearly, forever, for the purpose of regulating their business, electing wardens, vestry, secretary and treasurer; and the wardens of the society be and they are hereby authorized to convene the parishioners of St. Mark's Church society, at any time and place in Warren when they may judge it advantageous to the interests of the society.

Sec. 3. *And be it further enacted*, That the wardens and vestry, who have been elected to their respective offices, be and they are hereby continued in office until the annual meeting on Easter Monday next.

Sec. 4. *And be it further enacted*, That a proper book or books shall be provided by the society, for the purpose of registering and keeping an accurate account of all subscriptions, contributions, legacies and donations made to their society; and also the names of the donors, their places of residence, and the time of their being made.

Sec. 5. *And be it further enacted*, That the said society, at any of their meetings, may admit into their body such persons as shall wish to become members, and may appoint committees to prosecute the orders of the society, and to audit the treasurer's accounts as often as they shall think proper; and full power is hereby granted unto the said society, at any of their meetings, to make such rules, regulations and by-laws as they, or the majority of them, shall agree to, for the better regulating the affairs of said society; provided that such rules or by-laws be not contrary or repugnant to the laws of this State or of the United States.
