

Under G. L. Chapter 180

electd at its first meeting, in compliance with the requirements of General Laws, Chapter 180, Section 3, hereby certify that the following is a true copy of the agreement of association to form said corporation, with the names of the subscribers thereto:

We, whose names are hereto subscribed, do, by this agreement, associate ourselves with the intention of forming a corporation under the provisions of General Laws, Chapter 180.

The name by which the corporation shall be known is Work, Incorporated

The location of the principal office of the corporation in Massachusetts is to be the Town or City of Quincy, Street 34 Coddington

The purposes for which the corporation is formed are as follows:

We hereby waive all requirements of the General Laws of Massachusetts for notice of the first meeting for organization, and appoint the 11th day of June, 1970, at 7 o'clock P. M., at 16 Moon Island Road, Quincy, Massachusetts as the time and place for holding such first meeting.

To provide for special individual employment needs for a certain portion of the handicapped population who cannot function independently in the community, even in the least demanding work situation

To operate a sheltered work environment offering work sub-contracted from industry and providing jobs suited to the capabilities of this handicapped population.

To develop, conduct, administer and co-ordinate activities of this community facility for the handicapped population.

To negotiate contracts and sub-contracts with any and all agencies, public and private, including those agencies involved in the referring or servicing of this handicapped population. To negotiate and enter into work agreements with the individuals of the handicapped group; to provide, where appropriate and necessary, training for the individuals involved.

To enter into contracts or agreements with any and all industries, public and private institutions and any individual who may avail himself of production services offered by the corporation. The corporation shall relinquish any sub-contracts or negotiated agreements when said subcontracts and/or agreements are in violation, either in fact or in principal, of the union management agreement.

To provide facilities, personnell and funds in order to achieve and to assist public agencies and other private non-profit agencies or combinations thereof to achieve the goals of the corporation.

To make outright grants or loans of all or any part of the funds or property of the corporation with or without interest, in furtherance of or in connection with the objectives of the corporation.

To do any and all things directly or indirectly related to any of the foregoing activities and in furtherance of any and all of the purposes for which the corporation exists.

To do any and all other lawful things in furtherance of said charitable, educational and training purposes which may be permitted under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 and which are also permitted under the law of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, as is now enforced or amended.

To apply for and receive from any source or sources outright, in trust, by gift, devise, bequest or otherwise; and to hold cash, securities and real or personal property to the extent permitted by law. To receive and administer subsidies, grants, gifts and in-kind support from businesses, private or public agencies or any combination thereof and individuals concerned with the furtherance of the purposes and goals of the corporation.

To retain, buy or otherwise acquire, renovate, improve, sell, lease, convey or otherwise dispose of, and to invest and reinvest its assets in any property, whether real or personal, within or without the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, including without limitation any stock, obligations, or other securities of any corporation, association or business trust, investment trust or investment company, provided, that none of the assets of the corporation shall be loaned directly or indirectly to any Director or Officer of the corporation.

To make contracts, incur liabilities, borrow money, make and endorse bonds, notes and other evidences of indebtedness; and to mortgage, pledge or create any security interest in any real or personal property, all on such terms as the Board of Directors may determine.

Subject to applicable provisions of law, the corporation, may at any time, dissolve by the affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of the Board of Directors, provided that upon such dissolution all of the assets of the corporation (after the payments of all debts and other obligations) shall be equally divided among: the South Shore Mental Health Association, the South Shore Association for Retarded Children, the Rockland School For Exceptional Children, and/or such other non-profit organization whose goals are similar to the goals of Work, Incorporated, as designated by the Board of Directors.
