FOURTH: Provisions (if any) for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation, including provisions for the distribution of assets on dissolution or final liquidation, are:

1. The corporation shall have all the powers conferred upon a corporation organized under the provisions of the Rhode Island Non-Profit Corporation Act and any enlargement of such powers conferred by subsequent legislative acts, and shall have all powers necessary, proper, convenient or desirable in order to fulfill and further the purposes of the corporation.
2. The corporation shall be non-profit, shall not have or issue shares of capital stock, and shall not declare or pay dividends. No part of the net income or profit of the corporation shall inure to benefit of any member, director, officer, or other individual, or to the benefit of any organization not qualified for tax exemption under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code except as permitted by law.
3. The assets of the Corporation are irrevocably dedicated to the purposes described herein. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation. The Corporation shall not participate or intervene in, or publish or distribute any statements in connection with any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any provision of these articles to the contrary, the Corporation shall not engage in any activities which are not permitted for a corporation which is exempt from federal income tax under Internal Revenue Code section 501(c)(3) or to which contributions are deductible under section 170(c), 2055(a) or 2522(a).
4. Upon dissolution or final distribution of the Corporation, the assets of the Corporation remaining after payment of or provision for the liabilities and obligations of the Corporation shall be distributed exclusively to such tax-exempt organization or organizations described in Internal Revenue Code section 501(c)(3) as the board of directors shall determine. Any assets not so distributed shall be disposed of by a court of the State of Rhode Island to such tax-exempt organization or organization as the court determines.

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
