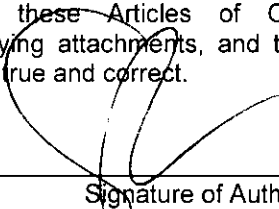

ADDENDUM TO ARTICLES OF ORGANIZATION OF
The Lares Group II, LLC

6. Additional provisions which the members elect to have set forth in these Articles of Organization:
