To whom it may concern:

The Division of Business Services, Business Filing Section was recently reviewing records marked within our corporate database as being under "BANKRUPTCY" status. On August 29, 2005, our office received the enclosed evidence from the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Delaware. The notice appears to have been interpreted to be applicable to New England Container Co., Inc. and the corporation was placed under "BANKRUPTCY" status.

An entity that has filed for bankruptcy protection cannot be revoked under the provisions of Rhode Island General Law 7-1.2-1310 *Revocation of Articles of Incorporation*. Records indicate the 60-day revocation notice issued to New England Container Co., Inc. on August 5, 2005 for its failure to file the 2005 annual report was rescinded upon receipt of the above-referenced document.

Each corporation is required to file an annual report with the Business Filing Section between the months of January 1 and March 1. New England Container Co., Inc. has been returned to "ACTIVE" status. To obtain "ACTIVE/GOOD STANDING" status, the corporation must file the outstanding annual reports for the years 2005 – 2015 (11 reports @ \$50 ea. \$550). Failure to file the outstanding reports will result in revocation proceedings.

Enclosed you will find a copy of the corporation's 2004 annual report together with the blank forms to complete the required filings. Please feel free to contact me with any additional questions.
