It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. The time within which East Greenwich Citizens Who Care, incorporated
2 October 2, 1984 shall file the reports for the years 1994, 1995, 1996, 1997, 1998, 1999, 2000,
3 2001, 2002, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014, and 2015
4 as required under the provisions of section 7-6-90 of the general laws of Rhode Island, 1956, is
5 hereby extended to the 31st day of December, A.D., 2015, if said corporation shall file in the
6 office of the secretary of state before December 31, 2015, the reports which it should have filed in
7 the said years and shall pay to the secretary of state the filing fees therefor, having previously
8 thereto paid to the general treasurer for the use of the state sum as the attorney general shall
9 decide should be paid by said corporation as a compromise for the penalty or penalties for its
10 failure to file such reports then the forfeiture or revocation of the charter of said corporation shall
11 thereupon, to wit, upon the filing of said reports and the payment of say fees, be vacated and said
12 corporation shall thereupon be entitled to all the privileges, benefits and powers and subject to the
13 same duties and liabilities as though no forfeiture or revocation of its said charter had taken place.
14 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
