EXHIBIT B TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

Motor Club Insurance Company

The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

- (a) To engage in the business of all risk insurance and related coverages, including property, casualty, and health insurance within and without the State of Rhode Island, except life insurance, annuities, title, mortgage guaranty, financial guaranty and workers' compensation;

- (d) To exercise all the rights and privileges of a domestic insurance company and to transact any and all business which a domestic insurance company may engage in pursuant to the Rhode Island Business Corporation Act, and Chapter 1 of Title 27 of the Rhode Island General Laws, as amended from time to time.
