1st. To associate ourselves together for the purpose of constituting a corporation under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Chapter 212 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1909.

2nd. Said corporation shall be known by the name of *The Cukland*
Beach Volunteer Fire Company

3rd. Said corporation is constituted for the purpose of *extinguishing fires*
and the protection of life and property

4th. Said corporation shall be located in *Cukland Beach in*
the Town of Warwick in the County of Kent in
said State
