Non-Profit Corporation Articles of Incorporation

(Chapter 7-6-34 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, as amended)

#### ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is Vanguard Christian Academy

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The period of its duration is **X** Perpetual

## ARTICLE III

The specific purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

The purpose of the organization shall be exclusively for charitable, religious and educational purposes within the meaning of the Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States of America revenue law), including, but not limited to, for such purposes;

- •To disseminate the Christian biblical model through training, education, publication and other media forms.
- •Establishing and maintaining of religious worship and operating of churches, schools, chapels, day care centers, camps, and any other ministries that the Corporation may be led of God to establish.
- •Develop excellence of ministry through conferences, seminars, training and Christian Schools, and other methods. To teach Christian Worldview by way of Christian Education, both formal and informal, to all ages.
- •Mentor, coach, and develop staff and other leaders in the academy and of other organizations, for ministries both internal and external of the Organization.
- •To be a Christian to establish the God's Kingdom using all methods of communication, through various types of services and interactions including but not limited to: worship services, deliverance, prayer, healing, revival, teaching, evangelism, prophecy. Baptism, communion, and the ministry of the Holy Spirit.
- •Purchase property, build facilities, and furnish for all the purposes herein.
- •To accept existing Christian organization's into Vanguard Christian Academy affiliation.
- •To develop a model of academy leadership and worship practice based on the model of the Biblical Academy.
- •To establish and participate in a network and affiliation of academy's and ministries for spiritual covering mentoring, training and fellowship.
- •To provide Christian counseling for domestic and personal applications.
- •To provide for reconciliation ministry with God and man.
- •To provide family building resources.
- •Intercession and other prayer types

Provisions, if any, not inconsistent with the law, which the incorporators elect to set forth in these articles of incorporation for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation are:

NO PART OF THE NET EARNINGS OF VANGUARD CHRISTIAN ACADEMY SHALL INURE TO THEBENEFIT OF, OR BE DISTRIBUTABLE TO ITS MEMBERS, DIRECTORS, OFFICERS, OR OTHERPRIVATE PERSONS, EXCEPT THAT THE ORGANIZATION SHALL BE AUTHORIZED ANDEMPOWERED TO PAY REASONABLE COMPENSATION FOR SERVICES RENDERED AND TOMAKE PAYMENTS AND DISTRIBUTIONS IN FURTHERANCE OF THE PURPOSES SET FORTH IN ARTICLE III HEREOF. NO SUBSTANTIAL PART OF THE ACTIVITIES OF THE ORGANIZATIONSHALL BE THE CARRYING ON OF PROPAGANDA, OR OTHERWISE ATTEMPTING TOINFLUENCE LEGISLATION, AND THE ORGANIZATION SHALL NOT PARTICIPATE IN ORINTERVENE IN (INCLUDING THE PUBLISHING OR DISTRIBUTION OF STATEMENTS) AND POLITICAL CAMPAIGN IN BEHALF OF ANY CANDIDATE FOR PUBLIC OFFICE. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THESE ARTICLES, THE ORGANIZATION SHALL NOT CARRY ON ANY OTHER ACTIVITIES NOT PERMITTED TO BE CARRIED ON (A) BY AN ORGANIZATION EXEMPT FROM FEDERAL INCOME TAX UNDER SECTION 501 (C)(3) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1986 (OR THE CORRESPONDING PROVISION OF ANY FUTURE UNITED STATED INTERNAL REVENUE LAW) OR (B) BY AN ORGANIZATION, CONTRIBUTIONS TO WHICH ARE DEDUCTIBLE UNDER SECTION 170(C)(2) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1986 (OR THE CORRESPONDING PROVISION OF ANY FUTURE UNITED STATES INTERNAL REVENUE LAW). IN THE EVENT OF THE DISSOLUTION OF VANGUARD CHRISTIAN ACADEMY, ITS PROPERTY, FUNDS, AND OTHER ASSETS SHALL BE TRANSFERRED TO WHATEVER ORGANIZATION OR ORGANIZATIONS OPERATED EXCLUSIVELY FOR CHARITABLE PURPOSES AS VANGUARD CHRISTIAN ACADEMY MAY DETERMINE, PROVIDED SUCH ORGANIZATION OR ORGANIZATIONS QUALIFY AS TAX-EXEMPT UNDER THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF THE UNITED STATES.
