CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION for the formation of:

INDIGENOUS NATIVE AMERICAN LAW AND JUSTICE CENTER.

NAME OF ORGANIZATION is, by INDIGENOUS NATIVE AMERICAN LAW AND JUSTICE CENTER, Council decree, tribally chartered and established under the Xi Anu Nation Tribal Trust and in accordance with the "CONSTRUCTIVE AND PUBLIC NOTICE" of the "Charter for the Xi Anu Nation TRIBAL TRUST CHARTER".

The XI ANU NATION Tribal Trust must file the "CONSTRUCTIVE AND PUBLIC NOTICE" of the creation and establishment of <u>Indigenous Native American Law and Justice Center</u> within 30 days of this notice. The notice must include that "<u>INDIGENOUS NATIVE AMERICAN LAW AND JUSTICE CENTER</u>" also known as "INALJC", is a tribal Organization tribally chartered and established under the Xi Anu Nation Tribal Trust This Organization Is Created And Operated In Accordance With The Charter And Public Notice Of Xi Anu Nation Tribal Trust And Is Owned And Operated Exclusively By The Xi Anu Nation Tribe.

This honorable, respectful and proper "CONSTRUCTIVE AND PUBLIC NOTICE" formally initiates the genuine efforts of the Xi Anu Nation Tribe to engage and establish the Indigenous Native American Law and Justice Center (INALJC). This notice also affirms the adherence to the Xi Anu Nation Tribal CONSTITUTION.

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION AND CERTICIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

INALJC is established under Section 17 of the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934 (Howard-Wheeler Act) as a learning Institution for Federal Indian Law enjoying tax exemption (see Revenue Ruling 94-16, attached herein). The object and aim of INALJC is to inculcate awareness of Federal Indian law, human rights law, universal law, the rule of law and Native American rights for a meeting of minds between the federal, state and tribal governments based on treaties including, but not limited to: Treaties signed since 1789. INALJC shall operate as a tribal court, a tribal law office and a tribal law college. INALJC shall focus primarily on creating and establishing a cadre of tribal lawyers to serve in the tribal courts for all indigenous Native tribes, clan, bands and nations recognized or unrecognized. INALJC shall receive donations and other emoluments from donors and patrons locally, regionally, nationally and internationally. INALJC shall have affiliate offices and partners from other tribal governments internationally including but not limited to: Canada, Australia, New Zealand, Fiji, Micronesia, Indonesia, Malaysia, Singapore, and South America. INALJC shall sue and be sued in its tribal capacity In the Event of corporate dissolution, INALJC's assests and liabilities shall accure to tribal governments including but not limited to: the Chakchiuma, Shinnecock, Naragansett, Comanche Xi Anu, Yamassee, Guale, Washitaw, Achaitak, Seminole, Muscogee and Creek nations to be divided evenly to the people. INALJC shall open bank accounts as and when necessary receive and send funds locally, regionally, nationally and internationally.

NOTICE OF AMENEDMENT

INALJC is American Aborigine' Superior Tribal Court & Higher Learning Institution of Cosmic, Universal and International Jurisdiction as an instrumentality exercising the tribal sovereign authority of its member states, thus possessing autonomous statehood (UN Jurisdictional Immunities of States, Article 2.1(b)(iii), Article 5), conducting external affairs as an institution of its member states, thus holding full sovereign privileges and immunites (UN Inadmissibility of interference in Affairs of States, Preamble: Point 1, Section 2(e), Section 3(a)), as a non-terriorial state (UN Diplomatic Relations, Articles 1(i), 3.1(a)).
