ORIGINAL ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION

(BUSINESS CORPORATION)

That we LOUISE K. MAXSON and MARION L. LYON Know all Men by these Presents. both of the City of Newport, State of Rhode Island, and JENNIE E. RYAN of the Town of Middletown, in said State - - - - - - - - - - - - - all of lawful age, hereby agree to and with each other:

FIRST. To associate ourselves together with the intention of forming a corporation under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Chapters 7-1 to 7-5 (inclusive), 7-9 and 7-10 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, as amended.

SECOND. Said corporation shall be known by the name of FOREST FARM, INC.

THIRD. Said corporation is formed (as permitted by § 7-2-3 of the General Laws) for the purpose of maintaining and operating a nursing home, convalencent home, rest home, i.e. a place or facility for the accommodation, care, hospitalization, treatment or boarding of sick, infirm, invalid, conualescent persons, or of aged persons; of buying merchandise and selling the same at retail in a pift shop on the premises in connection with the operation of said home; of maintaining and renting cottages and apartments located on the land of the corporation, separate and apart from said home; and of developing, leasing and selling real

In addition to the foregoing, said corporation shall have the following powers and authority, viz:—(See § 7-2-10 of the General Laws.)

To do any lawful act which is necessary or proper to accomplish the purposes of its incorporation. Without limit-or enlarging the effect of this general grant of authority, it is hereby specifically provided that every corporation ing or emarging of shall have power:

- (a) to have perpetual succession in its corporate name, unless a period for its duration is limited in its articles of association or charter;
 - (b) to sue and be sued in its corporate name;
 - (c) to have and use a common seal, and alter the same at pleasure;
- (d) to elect define their duties; to elect such officers and appoint such agents as its business requires, and to fix their compensation and
- (e) to make by-laws not inconsistent with the Constitution or laws of the United States or of this state, or with the corporation's charter, or articles of association, determining the time and place of holding and the manner of calling and of conducting meetings of its stockholders and directors, the manner of electing its officers and directors, the mode of voting by proxy, the number qualifications, powers, duties and term of office of its officers and directors, the number of directors and of shares of stock necessary to constitute a quorum, which number may be less than a majority, and the method of making demand for payment of subscriptions to its capital stock, and providing for an executive committee to be elected from and by the board of directors and defining its powers and duties, and containing any other provisions, whether of the same or of a different nature, for the management of the corporation's property and the regulation and government of its affairs;
 - (f) to make contracts, incur liabilities and borrow money;
- (g) to acquire, hold, sell and transfer shares of its own capital stock; provided, that no corporation shall use its funds or property for the purchase of its own shares of capital stock when such use would cause any impairment of the capital of the corporation;
- (h) to acquire, hold, sell, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge or otherwise dispose of any bonds, securities or evidences of indebtedness created by, or the shares of the capital stock of, any other corporation or corporations of this state or of any other state, country, nation or government, and while owner of said stock to exercise all the rights, powers and privileges of ownership, including the right to vote thereon;
- (i) to guarantee, if authorized so to do by its charter or articles of association, any bonds, securities or evidences of indebtedness created by or dividends on or a certain amount per share in liquidation of the capital stock of any other corporation or corporations created by this state or by any other state, country, nation or government;
- (j) to acquire, hold, use, manage, convey, lease, mortgage, pledge or otherwise dispose of within or without this
 state any other property, real or personal, which its purposes shall require;
- (k) to conduct business and have offices in this state and elsewhere; provided, however, that nothing in this section contained shall authorize any corporation to carry on the business of a bank, savings bank or trust company.
