1960. **AN ACT Authorizing the [unclear] Boys' Clubs to  
Take, Hold, Transmit and [unclear] and Personal  
Estate to an Amount Not Exceeding Two Million  
Dollars.**

**It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:**

**Section 1.** The Providence Boys' Clubs, a charitable corporation organized under chapter ~~173~~, general laws of Rhode Island, 1896, is hereby authorized, empowered and entitled to take, hold, transmit and convey real and personal estate to an amount not exceeding in all two million dollars (\$2,000,000).

**Sec. 2.** This act shall take effect upon its passage and all acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

**Resolution** making an appropriation of eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000.) to assist eight boys' clubs in Rhode Island; each club to receive one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500.) to assist them in meeting their expenses.

**Whereas,** One of the major purposes of the Boys'

Club movement is to combat juvenile delinquency which is so rampant throughout our country today; and

**Whereas,** The Boys' Clubs in the cities of Providence, Pawtucket, East Providence, and the towns of Cumberland-Lincoln are carrying on an effective fight against juvenile delinquency and providing a training program for good citizenship for the boys of those communities; now, therefore be it

**Resolved,** That eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000.) be made available to each of the twelve clubs as set forth below to assist them in meeting their operating expenses; and the sum of eighteen thousand dollars (\$18,000.) is hereby appropriated, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, for this purpose:

Central Falls Club	\$1,500.00
East Providence Boys' Clubs (two clubs)	3,000.00
Jamestown Boys' Club	1,500.00
Pawtucket Boys' Club (one club)	1,500.00
Newport Boys' Club	1,500.00
Providence Boys' Clubs (four clubs)	6,000.00
Middletown Boys' Club	1,500.00
Cumberland-Lincoln Boys' Club (one club)	1,500.00;

and the state controller is hereby authorized and directed to draw his orders upon the general treasurer for the payment of such sum, or so much thereof as may be required from time to time, upon the receipt by him of properly authenticated vouchers.
