Articles of Incorporation**

(Chapter 7-6-34 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, as amended)

**ARTICLE I**

The name of the corporation is MAXMATH TUTORING ONLINE INC., RHODE ISLAND BRANCH

**ARTICLE II**

The period of its duration is  Perpetual

**ARTICLE III**

The specific purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

(A) MAXMATH TUTORING ONLINE, RHODE ISLAND BRANCH IS CREATED EXCLUSIVELY FOR CHARITABLE, EDUCATIONAL ET SCIENTIFIC PURPOSES WITHIN THE MEANING OF §501(C)(3) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1986 (AS AMENDED) OR THE CORRESPONDING PROVISION OF ANY FUTURE UNITED STATES INTERNAL REVENUE LAW, INCLUDING FOR SUCH PURPOSES, THE MAKING OF DISTRIBUTIONS TO ORGANIZATIONS WHICH ARE RECOGNIZED AS EXEMPT FROM TAX

UNDER SUCH §501(C)(3).

(B) TO EXERCISE SUCH OF THE RIGHTS, POWERS, DUTIES AND AUTHORITY OF A NONPROFIT CORPORATION ORGANIZED UNDER THE NONPROFIT CORPORATION ACT OF THE STATE OF RHODE ISLAND WHICH ARE CONSISTENT WITH THE PRECEDING PARAGRAPH.
