ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

<u>Addendum</u>

4. Provisions, if any, not inconsistent with the law, which the incorporators elect to set forth in these articles of incorporation for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation are:

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, officers, directors, trustees or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Three above.

No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation; and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements supporting or attacking any particular candidate for office) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Corporation shall be empowered to distribute literature, give sermons, and take other actions to promote and propagate its religious beliefs and moral philosophy.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activity not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation except from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code; or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the U.S. Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, state government or local government for a public purpose. Any assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation may then be located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization(s) as said court may determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for charitable, religious, educational or scientific purposes.
