Sec. 2. The standing committee provided for by the  
second section of said act, shall consist of not less than  
six members ; and in addition to said committee and the  
officers of said corporation, said corporation shall have  
power to appoint and constitute committees and trus-  
tees, who shall make report at the annual meetings, and  
hold their places by like tenure as is provided in the  
fourth section of said act for the officers and standing  
committee of said corporation.

Sec. 3. The third section of the act to which this is in  
amendment is hereby repealed.

AN ACT in amendment of the act to establish the Paw-  
tucket and Providence East Turnpike Corporation.

*It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows :*

Section 1. The next meeting of said corporation shall  
be held at such place in Providence, or North Provi-  
dence, as shall be designated by the secretary in the  
notice by which he shall call the same ; and there-  
after the meetings shall be held at such place in  
Providence, or North Providence, as shall be provided  
by the by-law of the corporation, or at the place to which  
they shall from time to time adjourn.

Sec. 2. Any number of stockholders representing fifty  
shares shall constitute a quorum at any meeting of said  
corporation.

Sec. 3. Such provisions of the act hereby amended as  
are inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed.

AN ACT in amendment of an act, entitled "an act to in-  
corporate the Athenæum in Providence."

*It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows :*

The said corporation shall hereafter be known by the  
name and style of "the Providence Athenæum," instead  
of "the Athenæum," as is now by its charter provided ;  
and so much thereof as is inconsistent herewith is hereby  
repealed.
