AN ACT TO AMEND "AN ACT TO INCORPORATE CERTAIN PERSONS AS A SOCIETY BY THE NAME OF CHRIST'S CHURCH IN THE VILLAGE OF LONSDALE IN THE TOWN OF SMITH FIELD" PASSED AT THE JUNE SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY IN 1835.

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of said act is hereby amended to change the name of said corporation to "Christ Church in Lonsdale"; and also to increase the authorized holding by said corporation of property to a value not exceeding "Six hundred thousand dollars of real estate and personal property".

SECTION 2. Section 2 is hereby amended to give authority to said corporation to elect at a corporation meeting two wardens, a treasurer, a secretary, and not exceeding thirteen vestry men for such terms and in such manner and with such duties as said corporation may from time to time determine and set forth in its constitution and by-laws.

SECTION 3. All provisions in said act or in any amendment thereto inconsistent to the provisions of this act are hereby amended.
