Arthur Menard and wife; thence running southerly along the east line of said land to the northwest corner of land of Alfred Elson, Jr. and wife; thence running westerly, crossing said Menard land in the range of the south line of land of Ovila Blanchard and wife to the center line of the Mendon road, so-called and continuing on the same course to the boundary line of the towns of Cumberland and Lincoln in the Blackstone river; thence in a general northerly direction to the first mentioned place of beginning, is hereby incorporated into a district to be called the Cumberland Hill fire district. Said district may have a common seal, sue and be sued and enjoy the other powers generally incident to corporations.

Sec. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage and all acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

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AN ACT IN AMENDMENT OF AN ACT PASSED AT THE OCTOBER SESSION, A. D. 1823, ENTITLED "AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE AND ENABLE THE YEARLY MEETING OF FRIENDS FOR NEW ENGLAND, TO RECEIVE, HOLD, MANAGE, APPROPRIATE, AND DISPOSE OF PROPERTY FOR CHARITABLE AND BENEVOLENT AND OTHER PURPOSES," AS AMENDED, CHANGING THE NAME OF SAID ORGANIZATION TO "NEW ENGLAND YEARLY MEETING OF FRIENDS."

*It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:*

SECTION 1. That act, passed at the October session of the general assembly, A. D. 1823, entitled "An act to authorize and enable the Yearly Meeting of Friends

for New England, to receive, hold, manage, appropriate, and dispose of property for charitable and benevolent and other purposes," as amended by acts passed at the January sessions, A. D. 1875, 1893, 1923, 1929, 1933, 1940 and 1944, is hereby amended to change the name of said Yearly Meeting by striking out the words "Yearly Meeting of Friends for New England," wherever they may appear in said acts and substituting therefor the words, "New England Yearly Meeting of Friends."

SEC. 2. Section 2 of said act passed at the October session, A. D. 1823, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SEC. 2. And be it further enacted, that whenever said New England Yearly Meeting of Friends, at their annual or other meetings, held at such times and places, within or without the state of Rhode Island, as they may judge convenient, shall appoint a clerk or secretary, treasurer, trustees, committees, and other officers or agents, for any length of time as they may deem expedient, to act for them or in their behalf, the clerk or secretary, treasurer, trustees, committees and all other officers and agents which they shall or may appoint, in their usual ways and manner of appointing them, shall be considered and deemed to be their officers and agents, enumerated and designated in this act; and all minutes adopted, and all business transacted by said New England Yearly Meeting of Friends at such annual or other meetings, whether held within or without the state of Rhode Island, shall be binding and valid in all respects upon said body."

SEC. 3. That act, entitled "An act in amendment of

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an act entitled 'An act to authorize and enable the Yearly Meeting of Friends for New England to receive, hold, manage, appropriate and dispose of property for charitable, benevolent, and other purposes,' passed at the January session, A. D. 1875, and that act, entitled, "An act in amendment of an act passed at the October session, A. D. 1823, entitled 'An act to authorize and enable the Yearly Meeting of Friends for New England to receive, hold, manage, appropriate and dispose of property for charitable, benevolent and other purposes', as amended", passed at the January session, A. D. 1933, are hereby repealed.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect upon its passage, and all acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

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AN ACT INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY TO BE HELD, TRANSMITTED AND CONVEYED BY HOSPITAL SERVICE CORPORATION OF RHODE ISLAND.

Section 1. Hospital Service Corporation of Rhode Island, a corporation organized under articles of association filed in the office of the secretary of state of the state of Rhode Island on the twenty-seventh day of February, A. D. 1939, by authority of chapter 719 of the public laws passed at the January session, 1939, entitled "An act providing for the incorporation of non-profit hospital service corporations and defining their powers" is hereby entitled to take, hold, transmit and
