AN ACT TO EXEMPT REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY OF
TRAVELERS BUILDING ASSOCIATION, INC. FROM TAXATION.

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. After the passage of this act the city council of the city of Providence is authorized to exempt from taxation the real and personal estate of Travelers Building Association, Inc., a corporation created under the general laws of the state of Rhode Island, so long as it shall comply with the provisions of section 44-3-3 (14) of the general laws.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage and all acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

AN ACT IN AMENDMENT OF "AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE
'TRUSTEES OF THE METHODIST EPISCOPAL CHURCH IN
EAST GREENWICH'" PASSED AT THE JUNE SESSION 1835
(WHICH CORPORATE NAME WAS CHANGED TO "TRUSTEES
OF THE METHODIST CHURCH IN EAST GREENWICH" AT
THE JANUARY SESSION 1942).

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1 of "An act to incorporate the 'trustees of the Methodist Episcopal Church in East Greenwich'" passed at the June session 1835 (which corporate name was changed to "Trustees of the Methodist Church in East Greenwich" by a certificate form filed April 6, 1942 with the department of state is hereby amended so as to authorize said corporation to take, have, hold, possess, acquire, transmit and convey real estate and personal property of every description, not exceeding in amount, in all, the sum of three hundred and fifty thousand dollars.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

AN ACT RELATING TO THE TAX LIABILITY OF THE UNITED
TRANSIT COMPANY.

Whereas, The general assembly failed at its January session, 1952, in amending the charter of the United Electric Railways Company to terminate the authority of said corporation to operate street railways; and

Whereas, The actual method of operation by said corporation since the enactment of said amendment has not been as a street railway; and

Whereas, Collection of the gross earnings tax assessed against said corporation since 1953 as a street railway might result in irreparable harm to said corporation, endangering the economic stability of the areas served by said corporation and adversely affecting the health, welfare and convenience of a large portion of the population of our state and would further contribute to the
