WE, the undersigned Officers of TRUSTEES OF THE METHODIST EPISCOPAL
CHURCH IN EAST GREENWICH, RHODE ISLAND

a corporation duly incorporated under the laws of the State of Rhode Island,
HEREBY CERTIFY, that at a legal meeting of said corporation, duly called for the purpose,
and held in the Town of East Greenwich
in said State, on the first day of April, A. D. 1942,
the following amendment (x) to the ~~Articles of Association~~ CHARTER (or were) duly adopted
by the affirmative vote of five of its members, viz:—

"VOTED, That the name of the corporation known as "Trustees of the
Methodist Episcopal Church in East Greenwich, Rhode Island" created by
Act of the General Assembly passed at the June session of the General
Assembly 1835 and amended at the May session of the General Assembly
1880 be and it is hereby is changed to Trustees of the Methodist
Church in East Greenwich
and by the latter name shall be entitled to all the rights, powers and
privileges and shall be subject to all the duties and liabilities to
which it would have been entitled or subject had its name not been
changed.

Sec. 2 of an Act entitled "Act in amendment of an Act entitled,
'An Act to Incorporate the Trustees of the Methodist Episcopal Church
in East Greenwich passed at the June Session 1835" passed at the May
Session of the General Assembly 1880 is amended so to read as follows:

Sec. 2. Said corporation may take, hold, transfer and convey real
and personal estate to an amount not exceeding One Hundred Fifty Thousand
Dollars (\$150,000).
