

of the Washington Park Methodist Episcopal Church shall be determined in accordance with the provisions of the discipline of said Methodist Episcopal Church in the United States of America and the persons who from time to time shall hereafter be elected or appointed in accordance with the provisions of said discipline, members (commonly called trustees) of Trustees of the Washington Park Methodist Episcopal Church shall constitute for the time being the membership of the corporation hereby created, viz:—Trustees of the Washington Park Methodist Episcopal Church.

SEC. 4. The said Trustees of the Washington Park Methodist Episcopal Church and its successors shall have the entire management and disposal of all the property and funds vested in it in accordance with foregoing provisions of this act.

SEC. 5. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed and this act shall take effect from and of its passage.

AN ACT IN AMENDMENT OF SECTION 2 OF AN ACT ENTITLED
"AN ACT TO INCORPORATE CERTAIN PERSONS AS A SOCIETY BY THE NAME OF ST. LUKE'S CHURCH IN EAST GREENWICH," PASSED AT THE JANUARY SESSION, 1834.

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 2 of an act entitled "An act to incorporate certain persons as a society by the name of St. Luke's Church in East Greenwich," passed at the January session, 1834, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 2. There shall be a meeting of the corporation on the fourth Monday in January annually for the purpose of regulating their business, electing wardens, clerk of the vestry and treasurer; and the minister, wardens and a majority of the vestry be and they are hereby authorized to convene said corporation at the parish house of St. Luke's Church in East Greenwich or at such other place in said town as may be deemed advantageous."

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage and all acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE CENTRAL BAPTIST CHURCH TO TAKE, HOLD, TRANSMIT AND CONVEY REAL AND PERSONAL ESTATE TO AN AMOUNT NOT EXCEEDING FIVE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS.

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:

SECTION 1. The Central Baptist Church, incorporated under the provisions of chapter 248 of the general laws, as amended, is hereby authorized and empowered to take, hold, transmit and convey real and personal estate to an amount not exceeding five hundred thousand dollars, which real and personal estate shall be exempt from taxation so long as said real and personal estate shall be used exclusively for charitable or religious work or purposes.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage and all acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.
