

SEC. 2. Said society may receive, hold, transmit and convey, real and personal property to an amount not exceeding twenty thousand dollars.

AN ACT IN AMENDMENT OF THE ACT INCORPORATING ST. LUKE'S CHURCH IN EAST GREENWICH.

Passed May 28,
1874.

It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows :

SECTION 1. The act incorporating St. Luke's Church in East Greenwich, is hereby amended so that from and after the passage of this act it shall be lawful for said corporation, at its annual Easter meeting, or at any special meeting thereof, duly notified and called for that purpose by a vote of those members authorized by the by-laws to vote in the assessment of taxes, to assess taxes upon the pews, for all the necessary and proper expenses of maintaining public worship, as well as for the purposes of repairs and insurance, as now limited; Provided, that such taxes, in the present building, shall not exceed, in any one year, ten per cent. on the original valuation, for any other purpose than repairs, and in case of any new church hereafter to be erected by said corporation, such taxes, for any other purpose than repairs, shall not exceed ten per cent. of the valuation of the pews, that shall be made first after said corporation shall enter into possession of such new church.

SEC. 2. The amount of property which said corporation may hold under its charter, is hereby extended to forty thousand dollars.

SEC. 3. All portions of the act of which this is an amendment, inconsistent with this act, are hereby repealed.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
