SEC. 2. The real and personal estate of said Sons of Jacob Hebrew Academy, Providence, Rhode Island, shall be exempt from taxation so long as the same shall be used for the purposes of said corporation.

AN ACT IN AMENDMENT OF AN ACT ENTITLED "AN ACT TO INCORPORATE CERTAIN PERSONS, BY THE NAME OF ST. MICHAEL'S CHURCH IN BRISTOL," PASSED AT THE MAY SESSION, 1803, AS AMENDED.

*It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 2 of an act entitled "An act to incorporate certain persons, by the name of St. Michael's Church in Bristol," passed at the May session, 1803, as amended by an act passed at the June session, 1820, also by an act passed at the January session, 1834, and by an act passed at the January session, 1932, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 2. That there shall be an annual meeting of said corporation on Easter Monday, yearly and every year, at which meeting there shall, and at other legal meetings there may be, if necessary, elected for such terms and in such manner as may be determined from time to time by the provisions of the constitution and by-laws that may be adopted by said corporation, two wardens, vestrymen in such number as provided for in said constitution and by-laws, a secretary who also shall be vestry clerk, and such other officers as shall be judged necessary; that the minister for the time being shall

*ex officio* be moderator at all meetings of the corporation and of the vestry; that legal meetings of the corporation may at any time be called by the minister and wardens, or by seven members of the vestry, or by twelve members of the corporation, after giving reasonable notice; and that at any of the aforesaid meetings of the corporation, any of the affairs of the corporation may be attended to, transacted and performed."

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage and all acts and parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

AN ACT IN AMENDMENT OF CHAPTER 974 OF THE PUBLIC LAWS, 1940, ENTITLED "AN ACT TO INCORPORATE THE STONE BRIDGE FIRE DISTRICT AND TO FURNISH A SUPPLY OF WATER FOR THE TOWN OF TIVERTON," AS AMENDED.

*It is enacted by the General Assembly as follows:*

SECTION 1. Section 8 of chapter 974 of the public laws, 1940, as amended by chapter 1532 of the public laws, 1944, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

"Sec. 8. For the purpose of raising money to carry out any of the provisions of this chapter, the district is hereby authorized and empowered to issue bonds under its corporate name and seal, bearing not more than 6 per cent interest, per annum, payable semi-annually, at such times, not exceeding 60 years from the date thereof, and for such sums, as said district may at an annual or special meeting by vote decide, the amount for which said district may issue bonds not to exceed the sum of \$350,-
