## ORIGINAL ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned acting as incorporator(s) of a corporation under Chapter 7-1.1 of the General Laws, 1956, as amended, adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

FIRST. The name of the corporation is Commercial Properties, Ltd.

(A close corporation pursuant to §7-1.1-51 of the General Laws, 1956, as amended) (strike if inapplicable)

SECOND. The period of its duration is (if perpetual, so state) perpetual

Third. The purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

No stockholder shall sell or dispose of any of his shares of the common stock of the corporation without first offering the same to the corporation in writing for a period of fiftenn (15) days at the lowest price at which he is willing to sell; and if the corporation shall not, within fifteen (15) days after receiving from such stockholder such written notice, tender to the stockholder the purchase price of such stock, the stockholder shall be at liberty to sell such stock within a further period of fifteen (15) days to any other person at a price not less than binding upon each stockholder, his heirs, executors, administrators shares to a pledge as collateral security shall not be restricted but the provisions of this paragraph shall apply to any transfer or sale by the pledge in satisfaction of the pledge.

Sixth. Provisions (if any) for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation:

There shall be no Board of Directors of this Corporation unless the Shareholders take affirmative action to the contrary in accordance with the corporate by-laws.
