EXHIBIT A

MUSEUM OF PRIMITIVE ART AND CULTURE ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT Adopted 12 December 2017

1. Article 2 shall now read:

SECOND: The Corporation shall be known as the Peace Dale Museum of Art and Culture.

2. Article 4 shall now read:

FOURTH: The Corporation shall be located in South Kingstown, Rhode Island.

3. Article 5 shall now read:

FIFTH: This Corporation is organized and shall be operated exclusively for charitable, educational and scientific purposes in accordance with, and within the meaning of, Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended. The Corporation shall not contribute money or any thing of value to, or participate in, any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. No part of the net earnings of this Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, any member, trustee, or officer. The Corporation shall have no authority to issue capital stock.

4. Article 6 shall now read:

SIXTH: Without in any way limiting the foregoing, the Corporation shall have those powers granted by Title 7, Chapter 6 of the General Laws, and the following additional powers:

- 1. To borrow money and issue evidences of indebtedness therefor; and to secure the same by mortgage, pledge, or otherwise.
- 2. To employ agents and servants and in general to perform and do, either directly or indirectly, either alone or in conjunction or cooperation with other persons and organizations, all other acts and things necessary to accomplish the purpose of the Corporation, provided that such actions are in accordance with the applicable statutes and regulations of this State and of the United States.

5. Article 7 shall now read:

SEVENTH: The Corporation shall have one class of members. The affairs and business of the Corporation shall be managed by a Board of Trustees chosen from among the members of the Corporation. The trustees and officers of the Corporation, terms of office, method of selection, respective duties, and all things pertaining thereto, shall be as defined and established by the by-laws. No member of the Corporation except a duly-elected member of the Board of Trustees shall be entitled to vote.

6. Article 9 shall now read:

NINTH: Except as may otherwise be required by law, these Articles of Association shall be amended only upon the vote of two-thirds of the Trustees at a meeting duly called for the purpose pursuant to the by-laws, the notice for which shall contain the substance of each amendment to the articles to be considered; provided, however, that no such amendment shall authorize or permit the Corporation to be operated otherwise than exclusively for charitable, scientific purposes as set forth in the Third Article above, and in the manner required by the Fifth Article above.
