Articles of Incorporation

(Chapter 7-6-34 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, as amended)

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is Equal Cure Organization

ARTICLE II

The period of its duration is Perpetual

ARTICLE III

The specific purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

EQUAL CURE ORGANIZATION

THE EQUAL CURE ORGANIZATION TAKES AIM AT STATE AND FEDERAL LEGISLATURE FOR VIOLATING THE TITLE VII, CIVIL RIGHTS ACT OF 1964. THESE LAWS WERE INITIALLY ENACTED BY FEDERAL LEGISLATURE IN ORDER TO PROTECT INDIVIDUALS FROM DISCRIMINATION BASED ON THEIR RACE, COLOR, AND / OR ORIGIN IN PROGRAMS AND ACTIVITIES THAT RECEIVE FEDERAL FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE. IF YOU ARE ELIGIBLE FOR MEDICAID, OTHER HEALTH CARE, OR HUMAN SERVICES, YOU CANNOT BE DENIED ASSISTANCE BECAUSE OF YOUR RACE, COLOR, OR ORIGIN. THE OFFICE FOR CIVIL RIGHTS (OCR) IN THE U. S. DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES (DHHS) ENFORCES TITLE VII AS WELL AS OTHER CIVIL RIGHTS LAWS INCLUDING: THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT (ADA), THE HILL-BURTON ACT, AND THE HEALTH INSURANCE PORTABILITY AND ACCOUNTABILITY ACT (HIPAA).

THERE ARE MANY FORMS OF ILLEGAL DISCRIMINATION BASED ON RACE, COLOR, OR ORIGIN THAT FREQUENTLY LIMIT THE OPPORTUNITIES OF MINORITIES TO GAIN EQUAL ACCESS TO SERVICES. A RECIPIENT OF FEDERAL FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE MAY NOT, BASED ON RACE, COLOR, OR NATIONAL ORIGIN: DENY SERVICES, FINANCIAL AID OR OTHER BENEFITS PROVIDED AS A PART OF HEALTH OR HUMAN SERVICE PROGRAMS. ALSO, PROVIDING A DIFFERENT SERVICE, FINANCIAL AID OR OTHER BENEFIT, OR PROVIDING INDIVIDUALS IN A DIFFERENT MANNER FROM THOSE PROVIDED TO OTHERS WHO ARE PRIVILEGED BECAUSE THEY ARE OF A DIFFERENT RACE, COLOR, OR ORIGIN IS DEFINED AS AN ILLEGAL FORM OF DISCRIMINATION UNDER TITLE VII, EQUAL RIGHTS ACT OF 1964. SEGREGATING OR SEPARATELY THE MANNER IN WHICH A GROUP OF INDIVIDUAL(S) IS TREATED, IN ANY MATTER RELATED TO THE RECEIPT OF ANY SERVICE, FINANCIAL AID OR OTHER BENEFIT IS ALSO DEFINED AS AN ILLEGAL FORM OF DISCRIMINATION.

TITLE VII, CIVIL RIGHTS ACT OF 1964 PROTECTS

PROHIBITED DISCRIMINATORY ACTS

TITLE VII, EQUAL RIGHTS ACT OF 1964 EQUAL HEALTHCARE OBLIGATIONS

PROVIDE FREE ORAL AND WRITTEN LANGUAGE ASSISTANCE TO PATIENTS WHO HAVE LIMITED ENGLISH PROFICIENCY (LEP). THE U.S. SUPREME COURT HAS HELD THAT DISCRIMINATION AGAINST INDIVIDUALS WITH LEP IS CONSIDERED DISCRIMINATION AGAINST NATIONAL ORIGIN. THEREFORE, THESE INDIVIDUALS ARE ENTITLED TO EQUAL ACCESS JUST AS ENGLISH SPEAKERS ARE ENTITLED. THIS ALSO INCLUDES GIVING PATIENTS NOTICE THAT THEY HAVE A RIGHT TO THESE SERVICES. PROVIDE FREE WRITTEN AND ORAL ASSISTANCE TO PATIENTS WITH OTHER SPECIAL COMMUNICATION NEEDS SUCH AS THOSE WHO NEED AUDIO ASSISTANCE, LARGE PRINT, OR BRAILLE. POST SIGNS AND MATERIALS IN LANGUAGES OF THE SERVICE AREA'S PREDOMINANT CULTURAL AND ETHNIC GROUPS. THIS INCLUDES MAKING CONSENT FORMS AND OTHER ESSENTIAL DOCUMENTS AVAILABLE IN THESE LANGUAGES.

VIOLATION REMEDIES

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH TITLE VI, EQUAL RIGHTS ACT OF 1964 COULD RESULT IN A LOSS OF FEDERAL OR STATE FUNDING FOR THE HEALTH CARE ENTITY. FOR EXAMPLE, A NURSING HOME COULD LOSE THEIR FUNDING AND BE FORCED TO CLOSE. HEALTH CARE ENTITIES COULD ALSO FACE MEDICAL MALPRACTICE CHARGES. TITLE VII, EQUAL RIGHTS ACT OF 1964 NOT ONLY REQUIRES GOVERNMENT ENFORCEMENT, BUT ALSO PROVIDES A PRIVATE RIGHT OF ACTION IN FEDERAL COURT, A RIGHT TO SUE HEALTH CARE FACILITIES AND INSTITUTIONS THAT ENGAGE IN INTENTIONAL DISCRIMINATION THAT PREVENTS ACCESSIBILITY OR OPPORTUNITIES IN HEALTH CARE UNDER FEDERALLY FUNDED PROGRAMS. PATIENTS HAVE THE RIGHT TO SUE REGARDLESS OF THE FINDING OF AN OCR INVESTIGATION. DENYING MEDICAL PATIENTS THE RIGHT TO MEDICATE WITH NATURAL REMEDIES BECAUSE OF THEIR STATE ORIGIN FALLS UNDER TITLE VII, EQUAL RIGHTS ACT OF 1964 AS AN ILLEGAL FORM OF DISCRIMINATION. OVER THE LAST DECADE, A PLETHORA OF MEDICAL RESEARCH HAS BEEN RELEASE PROVING MARIJUANA / CANNABIS TO BE AN EFFECTIVE MEDICAL TREATMENT FOR MULTIPLE DISORDERS AND DISEASES.
