## ORIGINAL ARTICLES OF ASSOCIATION (NON-BUSINESS CORPORATION)

Know all Men by these Bresents, That we Elizabeth Bakst, M. Charles Bakst, Allen Scott, Barbara Scott and Rebecca Pearson		
all of lawful age, hereby agree to and with each other:		
FIRST. To associate ourselves together with the intention of forming a corporation		
under and by virtue of the powers conferred by Chapter 7-6 of the General Laws of		
Rhode Island, as amended.		
SECOND. Said corporation shall be known by the name of		
The Red Brick Nursery School, Inc.		
THIRD. Said corporation is constituted for the purpose of conducting a day camp, nursery school, or prekindergarten school and private school for children, and any other allied activity.

In addition to the foregoing, said corporation shall have the following powers and authority, viz:—(See §§ 7-6-7. 7-6-7.1 and 7-6-8 of the General Laws.)		
To do any lawful act which is necessary or proper to accomplish the purposes of its incorporation. Without limiting or enlarging the effect of this general grant of authority, it is hereby specifically provided that every such corporation shall have power.

(a) to have perpetual succession in its corporate name unless a period for its duration is limited in its articles of association or charter.		

- (c) to have and use a common seal and after the same at pleasure.
- (d) to elect such officers and appoint such agents as its purposes require, and to fix their compensation and define their duties.
- (e) to make by laws not inconsistent with the Constitution or laws of the United States or of this state, or with the corporation's charter or articles of association, determining the time and place of holding and the manner of cailing and of conducting meetings of its members and directors, the manner of electing its officers and directors, the mode of voting by proxy, and the number, qualifications, powers, duties and term of office of its officers and directors, and containing any other provisions, whether of the same or of a different nature, for the management of the corporation's property and the regulation and
  - (f) to make contracts, incur liabilities and borrow money

Said corporations hall be entitled to take hold, transmittand convey real and personal estate to an amount not exceeding in all one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000), provided, however, that the foregoing limitation shall not apply to certain corporations organized for the purposes enumerated in § 7-6-8. If any corporation subject to the foregoing limitation desires to take and hold property to an amount exceeding one hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$150,000) either originally or by amendment, such privilege shall be granted only by the general assembly on petition thereto

FOURTH. Said corporation shall be located in Barrington , Rhode Island.

## (Further provisions not inconsistent with law)

FIFTH The foregoing statement of corporate purpose shall be
construed as a statement of both purposes and powers, and not as restrict-
ing or limiting in any way the general powers of this corporation, or their
exercise and enjoyment, as they are expressly or impliedly granted by the
laws of the State of Rhode Island.
SIXTH This corporation is not organized for the pecuniary
profit of its directors, officers, or members; nor may it issue stock
nor declare nor distribute dividends, and no part of its net income
shall inure to the benefit of any director, officer or member; and
any balance of money or assets remaining after the full payment of
corporate obligations of all and any kinds shall be devoted solely to the charitable, educational and benevolent purposes of the cor-
poration.
