Attachment to Rhode Island

Purpose Clause

Receive, handle, store, warehouse, manufacture, process, market, purchase, sell and otherwise deal in the agricultural products of its members, nonmembers and others, including the processing and exporting of grain and other agricultural products. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the purpose of the corporation is to engage in any lawful act or activity for which corporations may be organized to do business under the laws of its jurisdiction of incorporation.
