ORIGINAL ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned acting as incorporator(s) of a corporation under Chapter 7-1.1 of the General Laws, 1956, as amended, adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:





ATTACHMENT TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
FOR OPUS BY COLLINS, INC.

5. The sale or transfer of stock held by any stockholder shall be subject to the following provisions:

A shareholder desiring to dispose of, or transfer his stock as aforesaid, shall first offer such stock for sale to the corporation at the lowest price at which he is willing to sell the same. If for any reason the corporation is unable to, or fails to purchase such stock, such stock shall be offered to the other shareholders of record in proportion to the number of shares they hold for a period of thirty (30) days at a price no lower than that at which it was first offered to the corporation.

If the remaining shareholders shall elect not to purchase said stock, the shareholder shall be at the liberty to sell his stock to any other party at a price not less than the price at which it was first offered to the corporation and to the remaining shareholders. This section shall not apply to gifts, sales or transfers by a stockholder to members of his immediate family.

6. The said common stock, without par value of this corporation may be issued for cash, personal or real property, tangible or intangible property or other consideration as may be fixed by the majority of the stockholders.
