**Non-Profit Corporation
Articles of Incorporation**

(Chapter 7-6-34 of the General Laws of Rhode Island, 1956, as amended)

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is Humans for the Future

ARTICLE II

The period of its duration is Perpetual

ARTICLE III

The specific purpose or purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

HUMANS FOR THE FUTURE IS ORGANIZED EXCLUSIVELY FOR CHARITABLE, RELIGIOUS, EDUCATIONAL, AND SCIENTIFIC PURPOSES, INCLUDING, FOR SUCH PURPOSES, THE MAKING OF DISTRIBUTIONS TO ORGANIZATIONS THAT QUALIFY AS EXEMPT ORGANIZATIONS UNDER SECTION 501 (C)(3) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE, OR THE CORRESPONDING SECTION OF ANY FUTURE FEDERAL TAX CODE. THE SPECIFIC PURPOSES OF HUMANS FOR THE FUTURE ARE TO CONDUCT CHARITABLE AND EDUCATIONAL PURPOSES.

THE PRIMARY GOAL OF HUMANS FOR THE FUTURE WILL BE TO ENGAGE IN CONDUCTING BEACH CLEAN-UPS AND PROVIDING DONATION BINS TO COMMUNITIES IN NEED. HUMANS FOR THE FUTURE'S SECONDARY GOAL WILL BE THE HOLDING OF FUNDRAISING EVENTS IN ORDER TO PROVIDE RELIEF AND ASSISTANCE TO COMMUNITIES IN NEED OF THE HUMANS FOR THE FUTURE'S SERVICES, WHICH ARE CONDUCTING BEACH CLEAN-UPS AND PROVIDING DONATION BINS TO COMMUNITIES IN NEED.

IN ORDER TO MAXIMIZE HUMANS FOR THE FUTURE'S IMPACT IN ITS ENDEAVORS, HUMANS FOR THE FUTURE AND ITS DIRECTORS MAY SEEK TO COLLABORATE WITH OTHER NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATIONS THAT FALL UNDER THE 501(C)(3) SECTION OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE AND ARE OPERATED

EXCLUSIVELY FOR EDUCATIONAL AND CHARITABLE PURPOSES.

AT TIMES, PER THE DISCRETION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS, HUMANS FOR THE FUTURE MAY PROVIDE FOR INTERNSHIPS OR VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES, WHICH WILL PROVIDE OPPORTUNITIES FOR INVOLVEMENT IN SAID ACTIVITIES AND PROGRAMS IN ORDER TO HAVE A GREATER IMPACT FOR POSITIVE CHANGE IN THE WORLD.

ARTICLE IV

Provisions, if any, not inconsistent with the law, which the incorporators elect to set forth in these articles of incorporation for the regulation of the internal affairs of the corporation are:

NO PART OF THE NET EARNINGS OF THE CORPORATION SHALL INURE TO THE BENEFIT OF, OR BE DISTRIBUTABLE TO ITS MEMBERS, TRUSTEES, OFFICERS, OR OTHER PRIVATE PERSONS, EXCEPT THAT THE CORPORATION SHALL BE AUTHORIZED AND EMPOWERED TO PAY REASONABLE COMPENSATION FOR SERVICES RENDERED, AND TO MAKE PAYMENTS AND DISTRIBUTIONS IN FURTHERANCE OF THE PURPOSES SET FORTH IN ARTICLE THIRD HEREOF. NO SUBSTANTIAL PART OF THE ACTIVITIES OF THE CORPORATION SHALL BE FOR THE CARRYING ON OF PROPAGANDA, OR OTHERWISE ATTEMPTING TO INFLUENCE LEGISLATION, AND THE CORPORATION SHALL NOT PARTICIPATE, NOR INTERVENE IN, (INCLUDING THE PUBLISHING OR DISTRIBUTION OF STATEMENTS) ANY POLITICAL CAMPAIGN ON BEHALF OF OR IN OPPOSITION TO ANY CANDIDATE FOR PUBLIC OFFICE. NOTWITHSTANDING ANY OTHER PROVISION OF THESE ARTICLES, THE CORPORATION SHALL NOT CARRY ON ANY OTHER ACTIVITIES NOT PERMITTED TO BE CARRIED ON (A) BY A CORPORATION EXEMPT FROM FEDERAL INCOME TAX UNDER SECTION 501(C)(3) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE, OR THE CORRESPONDING SECTION OF ANY FUTURE FEDERAL TAX CODE, OR (B) BY A CORPORATION, CONTRIBUTIONS TO WHICH ARE DEDUCTIBLE UNDER SECTION 170(C)(2) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE, OR THE CORRESPONDING SECTION OF ANY FUTURE FEDERAL TAX CODE.

UPON THE DISSOLUTION OF THE CORPORATION, ASSETS SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED FOR ONE OR MORE EXEMPT PURPOSES WITHIN THE MEANING OF SECTION 501(C)(3) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE, OR THE CORRESPONDING SECTION OF ANY FUTURE FEDERAL TAX CODE, OR SHALL BE DISTRIBUTED TO THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT, OR TO A STATE OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT, FOR A PUBLIC PURPOSE. ANY SUCH ASSETS NOT SO DISPOSED OF SHALL BE DISPOSED OF BY A COURT OF COMPETENT JURISDICTION OF

THE COUNTY IN WHICH THE PRINCIPAL OFFICE OF THE CORPORATION IS THEN LOCATED, EXCLUSIVELY FOR SUCH PURPOSES OR TO SUCH ORGANIZATION OR ORGANIZATIONS, AS SAID COURT SHALL DETERMINE, WHICH ARE ORGANIZED AND OPERATED EXCLUSIVELY FOR SUCH PURPOSES.
